If someone wants his or her picture to show up over a magazine cover, they can have their photo shot in front of a chroma key technology and then the background of the wanted magazine cover is digitally interposed to make the customized magazine cover.

The preferred type of chroma key technology filming is done in front of a soft green cyclorama. One of the most common studios outfitted for green "chroma key" screen filming is found in numerous green screen studios spread across Los Angeles. Most studios are equipped with a two wall soft chroma green screen technology cyc, a very exceptional, custom cut, and sewn piece of green foam which soaks up sound and reduces green spill because of the marginal reflection of foam. Due to the reduced green spill, subjects can be shot near the chroma key technology allowing these people more space to walk, run and dance around.

The soft chroma key technology cyc at these green screen studios is large enough to shoot five to eight grown ups from head to toe. With regards to the f-stop, the standard illumination makes use of 3 to 6k space light, which decreases the studio's heat and load from the power supply. The most important feature of soft key cyclorama is how good this sounds. It's just like filming in an isolation booth. The talent is surrounded in part by acoustical foam which restricts echo effect making shooting simpler to execute.

The most skilled film-makers encounter issues when one of the technicians is hoping to rush the filming process, declaring that the problems can be fixed within post production. Just about all this can lead to is very time consuming process along with higher costs.
